Program Foundation

The strength of our futurity lies in the quality and commitment of our stallion owners. The foundation of our program is built upon their annual participation through stallion nominations, which directly support the growth, promotion, and excellence of the Appaloosa halter horse.

Stallion Nomination Options

Option 1: One-Year Enrollment

- Stallion Nomination Fee: **\$1,500**
Due by January 15 each year
- Includes:
 - Featured advertisement on the official futurity website
 - Monthly dedicated posts across our social media platforms

Option 2: Two-Year Enrollment

- **Year 1:** Stallion Nomination Fee: **\$1,500**
Due by January 15
- **Year 2:** Stallion Nomination Fee: **\$1,000**
Due by December 31 of year 1.
- Includes all benefits from the One-Year Enrollment plus a reduced rate for signing a two year enrollment contract.

Eligibility

Foals registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club and sired by ApHC and AQHA stallions enrolled in the Appaloosa Breeder's Halter Futurity.

2026 Nomination:

- **2026 Foals (weanling class)**
 - **Eligible for 2027 Yearling Class**
- **2025 Foals (yearling class)**

2025 Nomination:

- 2025 Foals
 - Eligible for 2026 Yearling Class
- 2024 Yearlings

Flexibility & Inclusion

New for 2026

Junior Stallion Program

Stallions Not Yet Siring Appaloosa Foals: Two Year Commitment Required

- Introductory Payment Plan:
 - \$500 introductory nomination fee due at signing
 - \$1,000 due by December 31, 2026
 - \$1,000 due by December 31, 2027
- Stallion Nomination Fee: **\$1,500**
Due by January 15 each year
- Includes:
 - Featured advertisement on the official futurity website
 - Monthly dedicated posts across our social media platforms
 - Early enrollment = **more marketing & promotion** during prime breeding seasons
 - With \$500 due at signing, the Appaloosa Breeder's Halter Futurity will list and promote your stallion. This will allow you to jump start on your stallions career without breaking the bank before mare contracts arrive.

Foals become FUTURITY ELIGIBLE in upcoming years

- Entice mare owners to breed to your stallion by demonstrating clear commitment to prospective mare owners they will have a guaranteed futurity program eligible foal.

2026 Enrollment will make these foals eligible:

- Foals born in 2027
- Foals born in 2028

Two years of contiguous enrollment required which is designed to reward stallion owners who commit early and invest in the future of their breeding program.

This program is built to promote your stallion, support breeders, and grow the futurity — all while giving foals the opportunity to shine in the show pen.

Mare or Foal Owner Responsibilities

Registration Requirements:

All horses must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club. Foals born without Appaloosa color or characteristics must have a performance permit issued for all registration numbers beginning with an (N).

Foal Nominations (2026 Foals)

The Futurity Board of Directors has voted to **suspend nomination fees for all 2026 foals** sired by a futurity-eligible stallion.

Note: The Board of Directors reserves the right to reinstate foal nomination fees in subsequent years.

Foal Nominations (2025 Foals)

The Futurity Board of Directors has voted to **suspend nomination fees for all 2025 foals** sired by a futurity-eligible stallion. This decision was made to promote accessibility and encourage widespread participation in the futurity's inaugural year under the new organization.

Note: The Board of Directors reserves the right to reinstate foal nomination fees in subsequent years.

Futurity Classes at the Appaloosa World Championship Show

Futurity classes will be held the **day prior to the start of the Appaloosa Halter Events** and will include the following divisions:

Weanling Classes

- **Non-Pro Weanling Fillies**
- **Open Weanling Fillies**
- **Non-Pro Weanling Colts & Geldings** *(combined)*
- **Open Weanling Colts & Geldings** *(combined)*

Yearling Class

- **Non-Pro Yearlings** *(all sexes combined)*

Entry Fee: \$425.00 per class

Office Fee: \$30.00 per horse

Important Rule:

The **Futurity Champion** of any Non-Pro or Open **Weanling** class is **ineligible to compete as a Yearling** in the following year's futurity program.

Agreement Terms

By signing this agreement, the Stallion Owner(s), Authorized Agent(s), and Stallion Manager agree to the following:

1. Provide **one (1) print-quality digital advertisement** for inclusion on the official futurity website and social media platforms.
2. Maintain **membership in good standing** with the stallion's breed registry.

3. Maintain **at least one Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) membership** authorized to submit breeding reports and issue breeder's certificates for all foals sired.
4. File **stallion breeding reports in accordance with ApHC rules.**
5. **No mares shall be bred prior to February 1st** of any year the stallion is enrolled in the Futurity program.
6. Submit the **initial nomination fee of \$1,500 USD.**

Enrollment Options: One Year (2026) Two Year (2026 and 2027)

- a. All payments are **nonrefundable**. If fees are not paid in full, any payments made will be forfeited and the stallion will not be enrolled.
 - b. If the two year option is selected above, submit the second nomination fee of \$1,000 USD, no later than December 31, 2026.
 - c. In the **event of the death of a stallion**, a substitute stallion may be enrolled if the board is notified within **48 hours**, and **no frozen semen** is available. Substituted stallion's foals will be eligible only for **breedings occurring after the date of death.**
7. Stallions enrolled for the **2026 season** make the following foals eligible to participate:
 - a. Foals born in **2026**
 8. All correspondence will be sent to the address listed on this form. It is the **responsibility of the Stallion Owner or Authorized Agent** to provide any updates to the Futurity Secretary.

Sample Junior Stallion Enrollment Agreement

Junior Stallion Enrollment Program

Terms and Conditions

By signing this Agreement, the Stallion Owner(s), Authorized Agent(s), and/or Stallion Manager (collectively, the "Participant") acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions of participation in the Appaloosa Breeder's Halter Futurity Junior Stallion Enrollment Program:

1. Advertising Materials.

The Participant shall provide one (1) print-quality digital advertisement suitable for inclusion on the official Appaloosa Breeder's Halter Futurity website and associated social media platforms.

2. Breed Registry Compliance.

The enrolled stallion must maintain membership in good standing with its respective breed registry at all times during enrollment.

3. ApHC Membership Requirement.

The Participant shall maintain at least one active Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) membership authorized to submit breeding reports and issue breeder's certificates for all foals sired by the enrolled stallion.

4. Breeding Reports.

All stallion breeding reports must be filed in accordance with current ApHC rules and deadlines.

5. Breeding Date Restriction.

No mares shall be bred prior to February 1 of any calendar year in which the stallion is enrolled in the Futurity Program.

6. Marketing and Promotional Benefits.

Participation in the Junior Stallion Enrollment Program provides stallion owners with enhanced marketing and promotional exposure through Futurity advertising, promotional materials, and official program communications. Early enrollment is intended to maximize stallion visibility during critical breeding seasons and to ensure that foals conceived during the enrollment period are eligible for futurity competition in the following year. In recognition of early commitment, the Junior Stallion Enrollment Program is offered at a reduced introductory payment plan while still delivering substantial promotional value.

7. Enrollment Term.

Participation in the Junior Stallion Enrollment Program requires a minimum of two (2) consecutive years of enrollment.

8. Fees and Payment Schedule.

- a. **Non-Refundable Fees.** All payments are nonrefundable. If nomination fees are not paid in full according to the payment schedule, any payments made shall be forfeited and the stallion shall not be considered enrolled in the Futurity Program.

- b. Introductory Nomination Fee. The Participant shall submit an introductory Junior Stallion nomination fee of Five Hundred Dollars (USD \$500).
- c. Second Nomination Payment. A second nomination fee of One Thousand Dollars (USD \$1,000) must be submitted no later than December 31, 2026.
- d. Final Nomination Payment. A final nomination fee of One Thousand Dollars (USD \$1,000) must be submitted no later than December 31, 2027.

9. Substitution in the Event of Death.

In the event of the death of an enrolled stallion, a substitute stallion may be enrolled provided the Futurity Board is notified within forty-eight (48) hours of the stallion's death and no frozen semen from the deceased stallion is available. Foals sired by the substituted stallion shall be eligible only for breedings occurring after the documented date of death of the original stallion.

10. Foal Eligibility.

Resulting foals born in 2027 and 2028 shall be eligible to participate in the Appaloosa Breeder's Halter Futurity, provided all other futurity requirements are met.
